- The Management should follow the provisions of the Telangana Education Act, 1982; G.O.Ms.No.1, Education (PS.2) Department, dt.01.01.1994, as amended from time to time and Compulsory Teaching and Learning of Telugu as per the provisions of the Act No.10 of 2018, dt.30.03.2018, which came into force from 02.04.2018 and the connected Rules to this Act issued vide G.O.Ms.No.15, School Education (Prog.II) Department, dt:01.06.2018. The Government have also prescribed the books to be introduced for Classes I and VI which have to be followed for the Compulsory Teaching & Learning of Telugu language as per this Act 10 of 2018 & the connected Rules.

Now the management has applied for issue of No Objection Certificate for affiliation to CBSE, New Delhi to introduce CBSE Curriculum. The Management has fulfilled all norms/conditions of CBSE, New Delhi.

I am herewith forwarding the proposals in respect of Hi-Tech Scholars Residential High School, Athivally Village, Medchal Mandal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District for taking necessary action in issuing No Objection Certificate for affiliation to CBSE, New Delhi with the following conditions.

- Every un-aided school or upgraded aided school (without aid for higher classes) shall have its own fee structure to determine the fee to be collected from the students of various courses/classes for this purpose a Governing body shall be constituted in this regard.
- Getting the Parent Member nominated and constitution of Governing Body for the 2019-20 if not already constituted.
- Meeting of Governing Body in all schools and fix the fee structure and submit a copy
 of the minutes to District Educational Officer concerned.
- The Governing body attached to the institution is empowered to prescribe the fee structure. While fixing the fee structure, the Governing Body shall take into account regarding expenditure involving payment of salaries, rent, electricity, water, stationery and other miscellaneous expenditure.

- It is open for the governing body to take a decision to collect fees from students either monthly or quarterly or half yearly.
- The Managements of the Schools shall display the fees and other charges being
 collected in the Schools in the notice board of the school before the commencement of
 the admission, so that every parent can know the same and take decision for the
 admission of their wards in the schools.
- The Educational agency shall submit the annual administration report in the prescribed proforma to the competent authority for every financial year by the 30th September at the latest. Such report shall be supported by the audited statement of accounts of the school duly audited by Chartered Accountant. Separate accounts shall be maintained for each school.
- The School managements shall upload their schools information in the web site of the department including their fees details and other required information useful to the parents.
- The Management should follow the provisions of A.P. Education Act I of 1982/G.O.Ms.No.1 Edn. Dated 01.01.1994 and Telugu Language be imparted as I or II Language compulsorily.
